On 25 February 2021, AMOPA Ireland will host a conversation with Professor Cliona Ní Ríordáin. Professor Ní Ríordáin is a professor at Université Sorbonne Nouvelle in Paris where she teaches translation and Irish literature. She heads the ERIN research group and participates in the work of TRACT (EA Prismes). She is also a translator, notably of *Cavalier Passe ton Chemin* by Michel Déon (Lilliput Press 2017). She is the author of the monograph *English Language Poets in University College Cork 1970-1980* (Palgrave Macmillan 2020) and of three anthologies of Irish poetry. The most recent, *Young Irish Poetry: The Poets of Munster* (Illador 2015), is co-edited and co-translated with Paul Bensimon. The duo will be publishing a personal anthology of Gerry Murphy's poems, *Still Further*, with Circe in the fall. Professor Ní Ríordáin chairs the jury for the Irish Foundation's Translation Prize and sits on the Strategic Committee of the Irish Cultural Center, Paris.

Professor Ní Ríordáin will talk about her academic life in France.
